- Assess and reduce flood risk;
- Assess and improve water quality;
- · Monitor federal flood risk planning and activities;
- Educate residents of the watershed regarding flood risks and water quality; and
- Seek and allocate moneys made available to the Authority for purposes of water quality and flood mitigation.

WHEREAS, the 28E agreement attached to this resolution seeks to form the Winnebago River Watershed Management Authority, and

WHEREAS Worth County, Iowa has vested interest in the Winnebago River Watershed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Worth County, Iowa that

- 1. Worth County, Iowa will participate in the Winnebago River Watershed Management Authority,
- 2. That the attached 28E agreement is approved, and
- 3. The Chair of the Board of Supervisors and County Auditor are authorized to sign the attached agreement on behalf of Worth County, Iowa.
