- 2. The Public will not be a part of any agenda discussion, or Questions, unless called upon by the chairman. Any disturbance of the peace at the meeting will be dealt with by law enforcement.
- 3. Future Agenda Requests will be submitted in Writing to the Worth County Auditor by noon Thursday prior to the board of supervisors meeting.
- 4. All written Submissions will be reviewed by the board of supervisors & added to the agenda by the Auditor if deemed Appropriate.
- Agendas & Minutes to Board of Supervisors Meetings can be viewed online & the official minutes to every meeting are published in the Official Newspapers, the Northwood Anchor and Manly Junction Signal
- 6. Public Hearings will include a comment period in which individuals will have three minutes intervals to present their position on board actions proposed during the public hearings. The comments shall be relevant to the public hearing topic and not be repetitious. The board reserves the right to stop the comment period of any individual that does not follow this policy. This policy will be stated at the beginning of public hearings going forward as a courtesy to the public.
