

2018 Worth County Fireworks laws

Sales and setting off fireworks can be done each year in the unincorporated area's of Worth County from June 1st to July 8th during the hours of 9 am to 10 pm the exceptions on hours apply to the Saturday and Sunday before and after the fourth of July if not past the 8th of July and also on the fourth of July with the hours being 9am to 11pm.

Sales and setting off fireworks can be done each year in the unincorporated areas of Worth County from December 10th through January 3rd each year with the times of 9am to 10 pm exceptions on times will be December 31st 9am to 1230 am on January 1st and the Saturday and Sunday before and after December 31st the times will be 9am to 10 pm.

The law requires to purchase fireworks the person must be at least 18 years old.

Permits can be obtained for other times by filling out an application and submitting it to the board of Supervisors for approval.

Fireworks can only be set off on your own property or someone else's property with the owners permission.

Fireworks can not be set off on public property or state property, county or city parks.

If a burn ban is in place by the State Fire Marshall's Office the discharge of fireworks is also banned.

The County or City can set their own ordinances or resolutions reference fireworks

Worth County will follow state law

Joice Resolution No firewoks in City limits allowed

Fertile Resolution must have permit to set off in city, issued by the city for all dates

Hanlontown Resolution must have permit to set off in city issued by the city fr all dates

Northwood Can only set off fireworks on July 3rd and July 4th each year from 6pm to 11pm only.

Kensett Can only set off fireworks on July 3rd, July 4th and December 31st in to January 1st during the hours of 10 am to 1230 pm

Manly No person shall use, explode or discharge consumer fireworks on days other than June 1 through July 8 and December 10 through January 3 every year, between the hours of 9 am to 10 pm included in said period. Allowing until 11 pm on the 4th of July and the Saturdays and

Sundays before and after the fourth, as well as the Saturdays and Sundays before and after New Year's eve. On January 1st until 12:30 am.

Grafton no updated ordinance or resolution
