NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Worth County, Iowa hereby enact as follows: Worth County hereby makes an interfund loan from the Waste Water Fund to the Water Fund in the amount of \$17,705. Revenue for payment of the interfund loan will come from user fees. The loan will be paid in full by December 27, 2014.
